June 16/17 (11<sup>th</sup> OT)

June 23/24 (Nativity of St. John the Baptist)

**You, child, will be call prophet of *the* Most High.**

**For you will go before the Lord to *pre*-pare his way.**

June 30/July 1 (13<sup>th</sup> OT)

**Our Savior Jesus Christ *de*-stroyed death**

**And brought life to light through the Gos-pel.**

July 7/8 (14<sup>th</sup> OT)

**The Spirit of the Lord *is* up-on me**

**For he sent me to bring glad ti-*d*ings to the poor.**

July 14/15 (15<sup>th</sup> OT)

**May the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes *of* our hearts,**

**That we may know what is the hope that *be*-longs to our call.**

July 21/22 (16<sup>th</sup> OT)

**My sheep hear my voice, *says* the Lord;**

**I know them, and *they* fol-low me.**

July 28/29 (17<sup>th</sup> OT)

August 4/5 (18<sup>th</sup> OT)

**One does not live on *bread* a-lone,**

August 11/12 (19<sup>th</sup> OT)

**I am the living bread that come down from heaven, *says* the Lord;**

**Whoever eats this bread *will* live for-ev-er.**

August 15 (Wednesday, Assumption of the BVM)

**Ma-ry is taken *up* to heaven;**

**A chorus of *an-gels* ex-alts.**

August 18/19 (20<sup>th</sup> OT)

**Who-ever eats my flesh and *drinks* my bood**

**Remains in me and I in him, *says* the Lord.**

August 25/26 (21<sup>st</sup> OT)

**Ma-ny are the troubles of the just one, but out of them all the *Lord* de-livers him;**

**He watches over all his bones; not one of *them* shall be bro-ken.**

September 1/2 (22<sup>nd</sup> OT)

**The Fa-ther willed to give us birth by the *word* of truth**
